Official Rules

1. Purchasers must be 18 years or older; no residency requirements.
2. Ticket price is a non-refundable \$50 per raffle ticket. There is no maximum number of tickets that any one person may purchase. No more than 1,000 tickets will be sold.
3. There will be one prizewinner for the Dollars for Education. The winner may choose either the 529 Education Savings Program option—i.e., 50/50 raffle with half the gross ticket proceeds being directed into a 529 Education Savings Plan; OR a Cash Prize Option of 40% of the gross ticket proceeds paid in a lump sum.
 - a. The 529 Education Savings Program Option:
Winner's share of 50% of gross ticket proceeds will be deposited into a 529 Education Savings Plan of the winner's choice. For more information regarding 529 accounts go to www.misaves.com or call 877-861-6377. Winner must set up and/or identify the 529 plan(s) for deposit no later than June 24, 2011.
 - b. The Cash Prize Option (alternative to the 529 option):
Winner may choose cash equal to 40% of the gross ticket proceeds paid in a single payment.
4. The drawing from the pool of numbered tickets to determine the winner will be held on Wednesday, May 11, 2011 at the TYA Youth Recognition Event at the Athens High School Auditorium, 4333 John R Road, Troy MI 48085, at 8:00 pm. (In case of inclement weather/extenuating circumstances, another date/time/location for drawing will be announced within 48 hours.)
5. The winner need not be present to win. A diligent effort will be made to locate the winner, but if he/she cannot be located within 60 days, the prize will be distributed in accordance with State of Michigan Rule 515.
6. The winner must provide proper identification. Winnings are subject to federal tax withholding per IRS Publication 3079.
